How to play

Remove the four Aces from the pack and lay them at the top of the table as foundation cards. Below them, deal 12 cards face up. For convenience, these may be arranged on the table in three rows of four cards each (see illustration).

The object of the game is to build ascending suit sequences up to the Kings on the Aces.

The cards in the layout are available to be built on the foundations, or packed onto each other in descending suit sequences. Only one card may be moved at a time.

The stock is dealt one card at a time and any card that cannot be built on a foundation or packed on the layout is played to a waste heap, the top card of which is always available for play.

Any vacancy in the layout is filled with the top card of the waste heap, or the top card from the stock if there is no waste heap. Only one deal is allowed.

With the layout in the illustration, the ♦2 is built on the ♦A. The ♠5 is packed on the ♠6 and the ♠4 on the ♠5. The ♣8 is packed on the ♣9, and the ♦9 on the ♦10, followed by cards from the waste heap or stock as necessary.
